In early , on re-organisation, Brigade consisted of the 1st and 2nd (Regular) and the 15th (Service) Battalions of the Royal Irish Rifles. In March the 36th Division, in the St Quentin Sector, was part of the Fifth Army and it was upon this Army that .

The 36th (Ulster) Division was an infantry division of the British Army, part of Lord Kitchener's New Army, formed in September Originally called the Ulster Division, it was made up of mainly members of the Ulster Volunteer Force, who formed thirteen additional battalions for three existing regiments: the Royal Irish Fusiliers, the Royal Irish Rifles and the Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers. Thirteen battalions were raised for the three Irish regiments based in Ulster: the Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, the Royal Irish Fusiliers and the Royal Irish Rifles. August: formed in Ireland as the Ulster Division, with Brigades numbered 1,2 and 3.

The 1st Battalion, London Irish Rifles formed part of the 1st London Infantry Brigade, itself part of the 1st London Division; in November the battalion transferred to the 2nd London Brigade, which was soon renumbered as the th (London) Infantry Brigade, due to the division's redesignation as the 56th (London) Infantry Division.
